invites applications for FELLOWSHIP IN HEAD AND NECK ONCOLOGY. The Course shall commence from 1st April 2026. The fellowship in head and neck oncology for 1 seat for duration 2 year (5th batch).

Educational Objectives:-

- The goals of this fellowship provide comprehensive, multidisciplinary training to individuals who committed to a career in head and neck oncology.
- The fellowship program will be a 2 year program.
- The fellowship training will provide a broad exposure to the full range of clinical problems encountered in head and neck oncology practice.

Upon completion of the 2-year fellowship in Head and Neck oncology, the surgeon will demonstrate the following competencies:

- Expertise in the multidisciplinary management of patients with oral cancer & Neck cancer**
- Principles of radiation and medical oncology, maxillofacial prosthetics, wound healing, reconstructive anatomy, oncologic nutrition, diagnostic imaging, and rehabilitation of speech and swallowing.**
- Expertise in conservation surgical procedures.**
- Judgement and ability to perform complex tumour resection and an understanding of the technical limitation of the procedures.**
- Knowledge and/or skills in microvascular free flap reconstruction.**

Fellowship Curriculum:-

The fellowship will provide exposure to the following:

- Principles and techniques of head and neck pathology including:
 1. paranasal sinus malignancies
 2. head and neck sarcomas
 3. salivary gland neoplasms
 4. oral cavity defects
 5. oropharyngeal cancer defects

The learning process will be facilitated by:-

- Development of clinical expertise by working closely with head and neck oncologists, reconstructive surgeons, radiation oncologists, medical oncologists, and allied specialties.
- Participation in multidisciplinary tumour boards and case discussions.
- Progressive hands-on operative experience, including assisting and performing head and neck oncologic and reconstructive procedures under supervision.
- Scholarly activity in the form of at least one research project leading to a publication in a peer-reviewed oncology or reconstructive surgery journal, along with involvement in community-based cancer prevention, screening, or rehabilitation programs.

Eligibility for Fellowship:-

- MS / DNB (Surgery / ENT), MDS (Oral and maxillofacial surgery).
- Registration with State Medical Council / Dental Council of India is must.

Stipend:-

- 1st Year: 30,000/
- 2nd Year: 50,000/

- Candidate will be entitled to 20 days leave during the entire period of course.
- Publication of minimum five paper in any indexed journal, (National or International) is mandatory during the tenure of fellowship.
